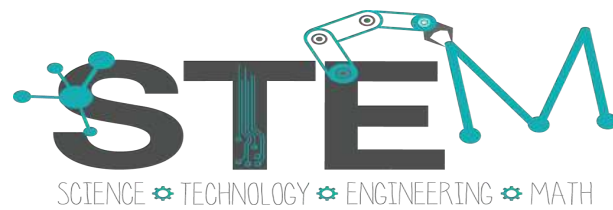
Do you know that some teachers have class pets? Yep, they have pets in their classrooms and the students get to help take care of them.

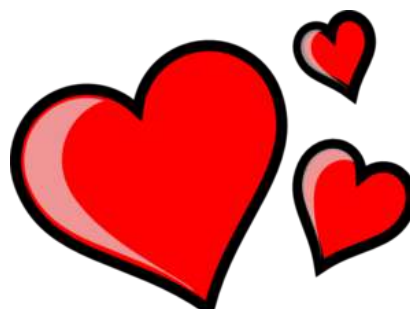

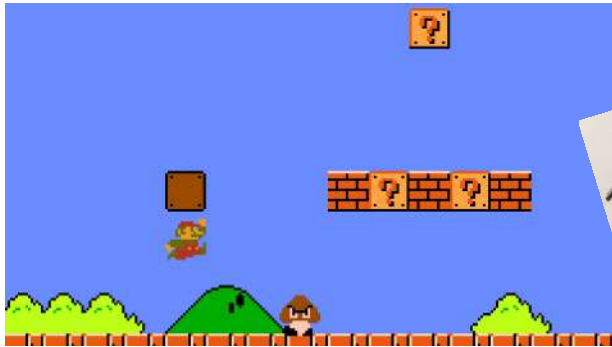

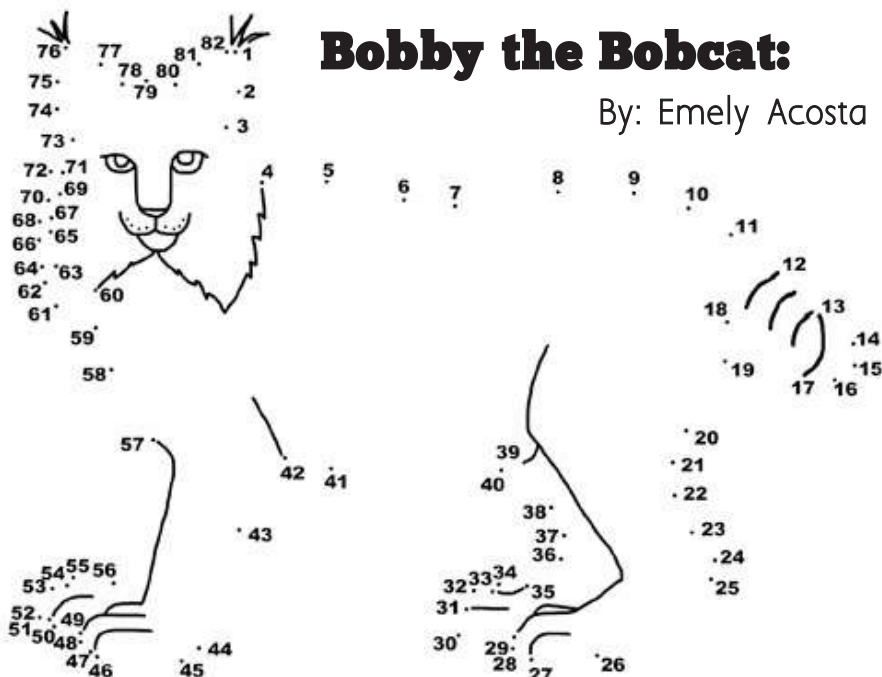
